## 1 CONDITIONS OF PLAY

- (a) Each Championship shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by R&A Rules Limited and with the Local Rules of each host course.  
Each Championship will comprise 36 holes of stroke play over two days i.e. First round Thursday and second round Friday.
- (b) Each Championship will be under the charge of the host club's Committee to whom all disputes will be referred and whose decision shall be final. The Committee reserves the right to amend the Conditions of the Championship.
- (c) The winner of each Championship shall be the competitor who returns the lowest score for 36 holes.
- (d) Prize vouchers will be presented to leading competitors in scratch, handicap and age group categories. The prize fund will be included with each draw.
- (e) In the event of a tie after 36 holes, the Championship shall be decided by a card countback based on the second round. In the event of a tie after 36 holes for any of the remaining prize winning positions, vouchers will be shared relative to the finishing position and number of players tying.
- (f) In the event of a competitor having to withdraw prior to each Championship contact must be made to a Scottish Seniors Golfing Society or Host Club Official.
- (g) In the event of a competitor having to scratch after the closing date, the entry fee will not be refunded.
- (h) The ball the player plays must be named on the current List of Conforming Golf Balls issued by the R&A.
- (i) The driver the competitor carries must have a clubhead, identified by model and loft, that is named on the current List of Conforming Driver Heads issued by R&A Rules Limited. Note: Any individual driver on the List, if tested on pendulum testing apparatus approved by R&A Rules Limited, must not have a characteristic time greater than 257 microseconds.  
Penalty for Breach of Condition: Disqualification.
- (j) During the stipulated round, a competitor may not use a motorised vehicle unless specifically authorised by the Committee.

## 2 QUALIFICATION

### To be eligible entrants must

- (a) be male at birth and be of Amateur Status as defined by R&A Rules Limited, a declaration to that effect being in the entry form,
- (b) be over 50 years on the start day of the Competition,
- (c) be in possession of a handicap **NOT EXCEEDING TWELVE STROKES** (exact 12.4) under the current CONGU Unified Handicapping System or the handicapping scheme adopted in the country from which the entrant has entered on the date that the entry form is certified by the Secretary of the entrant's Home Club.  
**THE EXACT HANDICAP CERTIFIED ON THE DATE OF ENTRY WILL BE USED FOR ALL PURPOSES**

## 3 ENTRIES

- (a) An entrant who is a member of a golf club in Great Britain or Ireland must enter through the Secretary of his Home Club and the entry must be made on this form.
- (b) An entrant from outwith Great Britain and Ireland must enter on this form through the Secretary of the recognised authority controlling golf in the country from which he wishes to enter and his entry must be accompanied by a declaration signed by the Secretary that he is eligible in accordance with the qualifications set out above.
- (c) A maximum field of 140 competitors will apply to each Championship in the event of an over-entry the number shall be reduced in order of exact handicap. Entrants who have failed to gain entry will be allocated to a reserve list by order of handicap. Reserves may be able to compete subject to subsequent withdrawals. Entry fees will be refunded to entrants who fail to gain entry.
- (d) Entries must be sent to the Scottish Seniors Golfing Society accompanied by the entry fee of £25. Postal orders will not be accepted and no receipt of entry will be issued.
- (e) All entries are subject to the approval of the Scottish Seniors Golfing Society Committee who reserve the right to refuse or accept or, having accepted, subsequently reject any entry and shall not be called upon to give any reason for their action.
- (f) Entry closing dates, three weeks prior to the event.

## 4 REGISTRATION

Competitors are required to register in each host clubhouse prior to their first tee off time.
